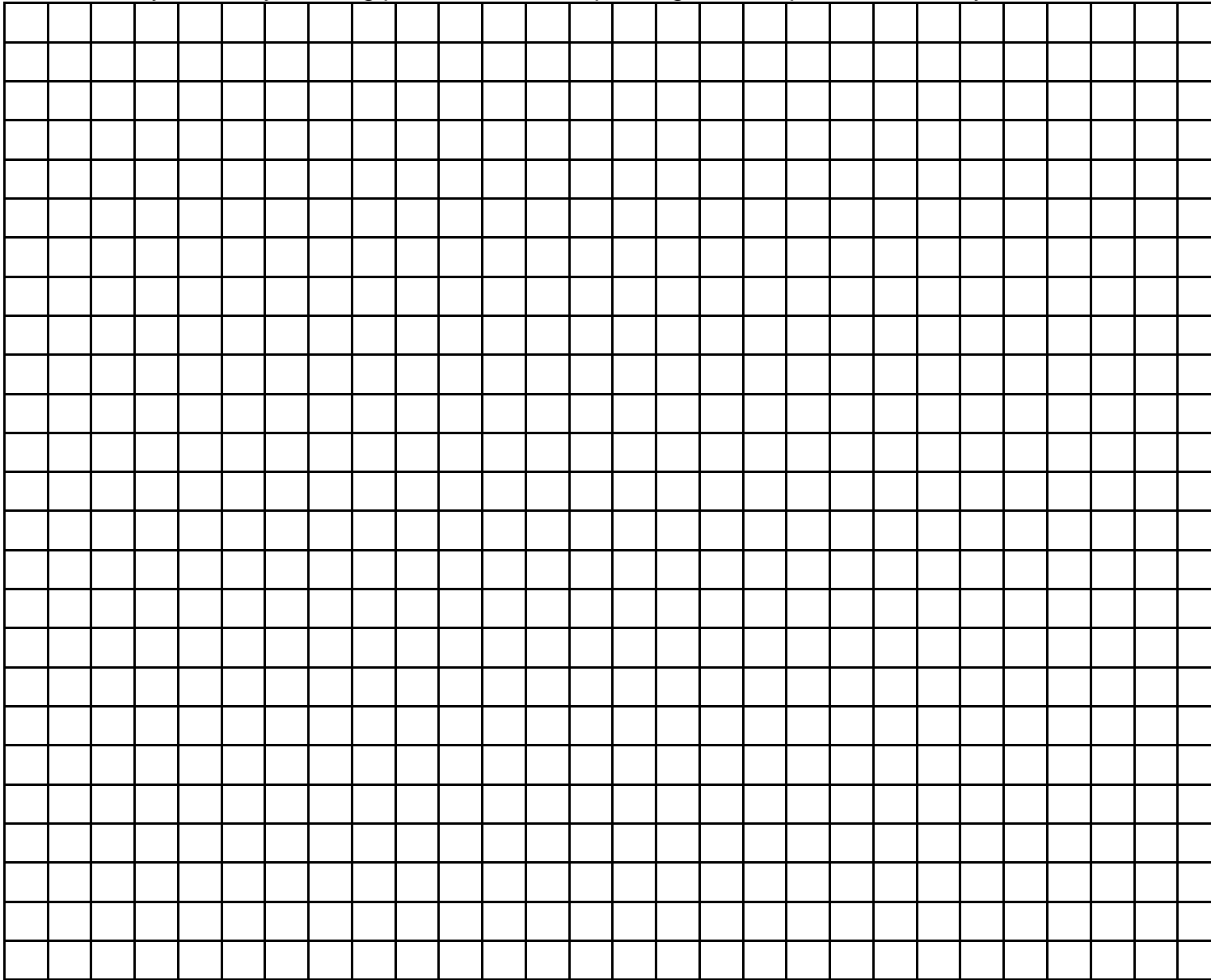


Our Family Fire Escape Plan

Use the graph below to draw your home's floor plan and map your home fire escape routes.

Mark where your family meeting place is on the map. Hang finished plan where everyone can see it.



Tips for creating your home fire escape plan:

1. Everyone in the family should know TWO ways out of every room.
2. Decide where your family meeting place will be in the front yard.
3. The whole family should practice together.
4. Time your drills. You may only have 2 minutes or less to escape in a real fire.
5. Test your smoke alarms monthly. Change the batteries twice a year.

In the case of a real fire:

1. Get out and stay out! Never go back inside for people, pets or things.
2. Call 9-1-1 once you are outside.
3. If smoke is visible in the room, get low and crawl.
